



SPORTING TIPS

PICKLEBALL Tip: Effective Communication

If you're playing with a partner, strategizing off the court before play begins can exponentially improve how you fare during a match. Here are some talking points to consider before each game: Calling shots is one of the best ways to communicate during gameplay. Here are the top ways to communicate during a pickleball match. Get in the habit of calling "mine" or "yours" for every incoming shot. Call "switch" if you'll shift to your partner's side of the court. Call "out" if a shot will land out of bounds. Encourage your partner throughout the game to boost their confidence.

TENNIS Tip: Ball Tracking

Being in the ready position means having your racket up and in front of you. Additionally, once you have your racket in front, players should be tracking the movement of the ball with your racket. This does not mean you should be waving around the racket like you are a wizard with a wand. Rather, players always track the ball and mimic its path with their racket. This tip also applies if the ball is not being hit at you. One common mistake is not anticipating where the ball will go, this could be costly because shots altered by wind, spin, and net cord contact.

BOCCE Tip: Placement

The Strategic placement of your bocce balls is crucial for outsmarting your opponents and securing points. Instead of solely focusing on getting your balls closest to the pallino, consider the strategic value of positioning your balls in strategic locations. Aim to create obstacles for your opponents, block potential pathways to the pallino, or set up opportunities for future scoring plays. By thinking strategically and planning your shots, you can gain a tactical advantage on the bocce court.
